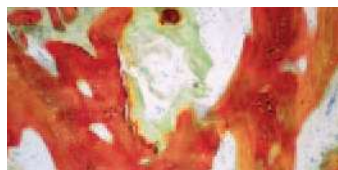

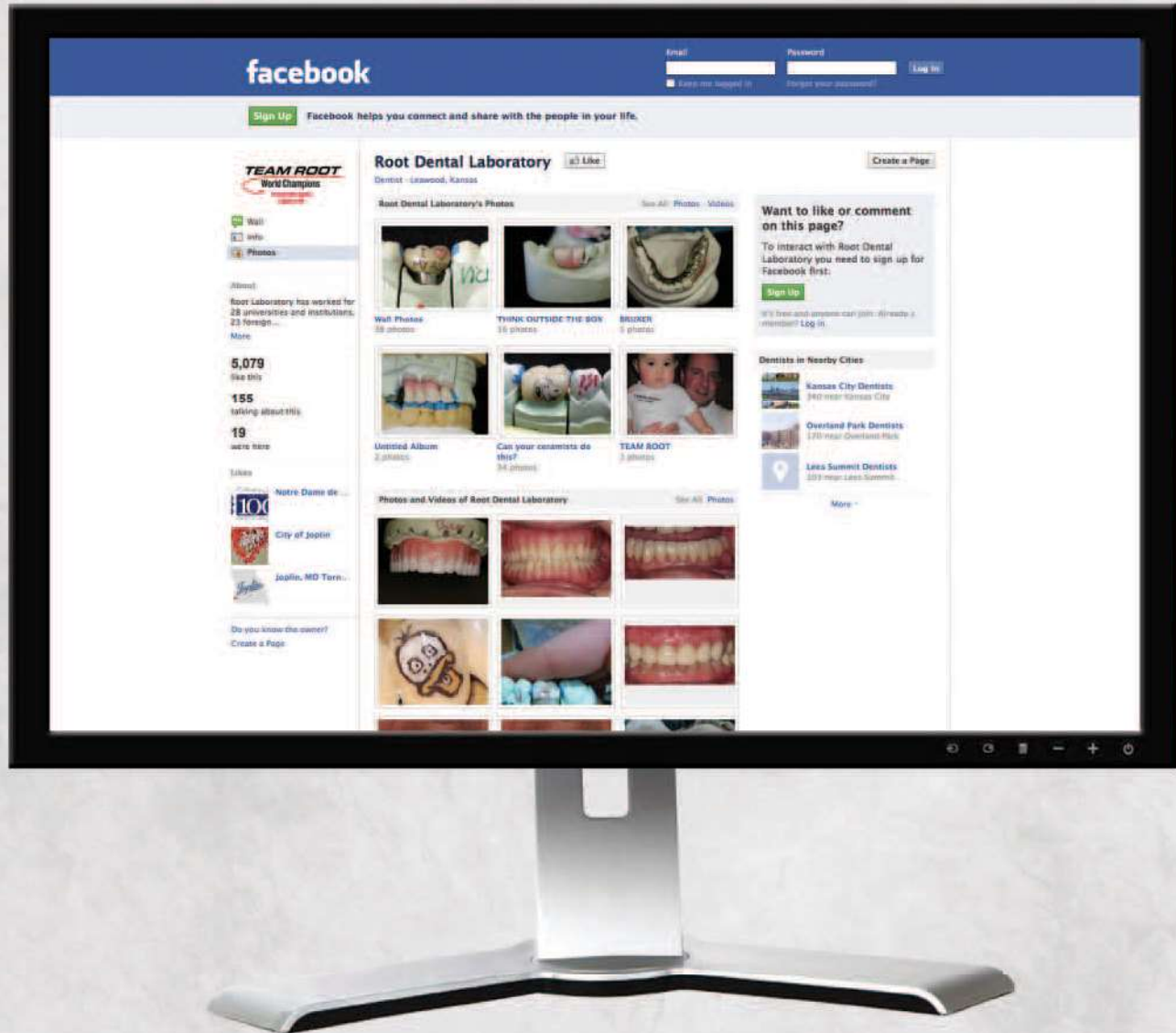

ICOI and Taipei Medical University Form Ties

On April 6-8, 2012 a number of Japanese and Taiwanese doctors attended the ICOI Diplomate Examination seminar conducted by Dr. Ady Palti at Taipei Medical University. At that time it was announced that the ICOI and Taipei Medical University College of Oral Medicine had started collaboration on providing a curriculum for dental implant continuing education for dentists, laboratory technicians and dental hygienists.

Dr. Keng-Liang Ou Appointed Dean of Taipei Medical University

Taipei Medical University (TMU) Dean Keng-Liang Ou is devoted to innovative research and community service. As both a scholar and a practitioner who specializes in bioengineering, nanotechnology and medical analysis, this outstanding TMU professor's inauguration as College of Oral Medicine Dean has drawn attention from many professions and disciplines.

Among his many awards, Dean Ou recently was recognized as this year's Top 10 Outstanding Youth Award recipient in Medicine. This is Taiwan's highest achievement award and honor, and it is only given to one awardee every year.

Dean Ou has put great efforts into collaboration across many fields, and he set out to connect engineering research and clinical applications. It is Dean Ou's belief that medical science should not be limited to academic research. To expand the scope of medical science and serve more people in the community, biomedical researchers must collaborate with leaders in biomedical industries.

Dean Ou has received numerous awards for his innovations and accomplishments. He received the Award for Outstanding Contributions in Technology Transfer, the National Science Council Award, the National Innovation Award, and the Institute for Biotechnology and Medicine Industry (IBMI) Award in 2008. Dean Ou received the 2011 Most Significant Contribution Award in medical science from Crimean State Medical University, and two Silver Medal awards at the 14th Moscow International Salon of Inventions and Innovation Technologies in April; in June he

received 6 Gold Medal Awards and 1 Silver Medal Award at the Inventeco International Invention Show in Italy acknowledging his achievements in interdisciplinary collaboration. Dean Ou received 2 Gold Medals and 2 Silver Medals at the 7th annual Ukraine International Salon of Inventions and New Technologies for an implant system in September, and in November he won 5 Gold Medals and 1 Silver Medal at the 5th annual Poland International Warsaw of Inventions and New Technologies for Innovation in Biomedical Devices with Nanodiamond. These awards not only recognize the team's effort in research innovation but also encourage overall development of medical equipment in Taiwan.

As the senior population increases, the need for dental implantation also rises significantly. Under Dean Ou's supervision, the team worked on a real-time monitoring system for assessing implants. This system is designed for application in home care settings to improve quality of life. With the aforementioned international and national awards and the invention of Tione one-piece implant, Taipei Medical University's Professor Keng-Liang Ou earned the 2011 Top 10 Outstanding Youth Award in the category of Medicine.

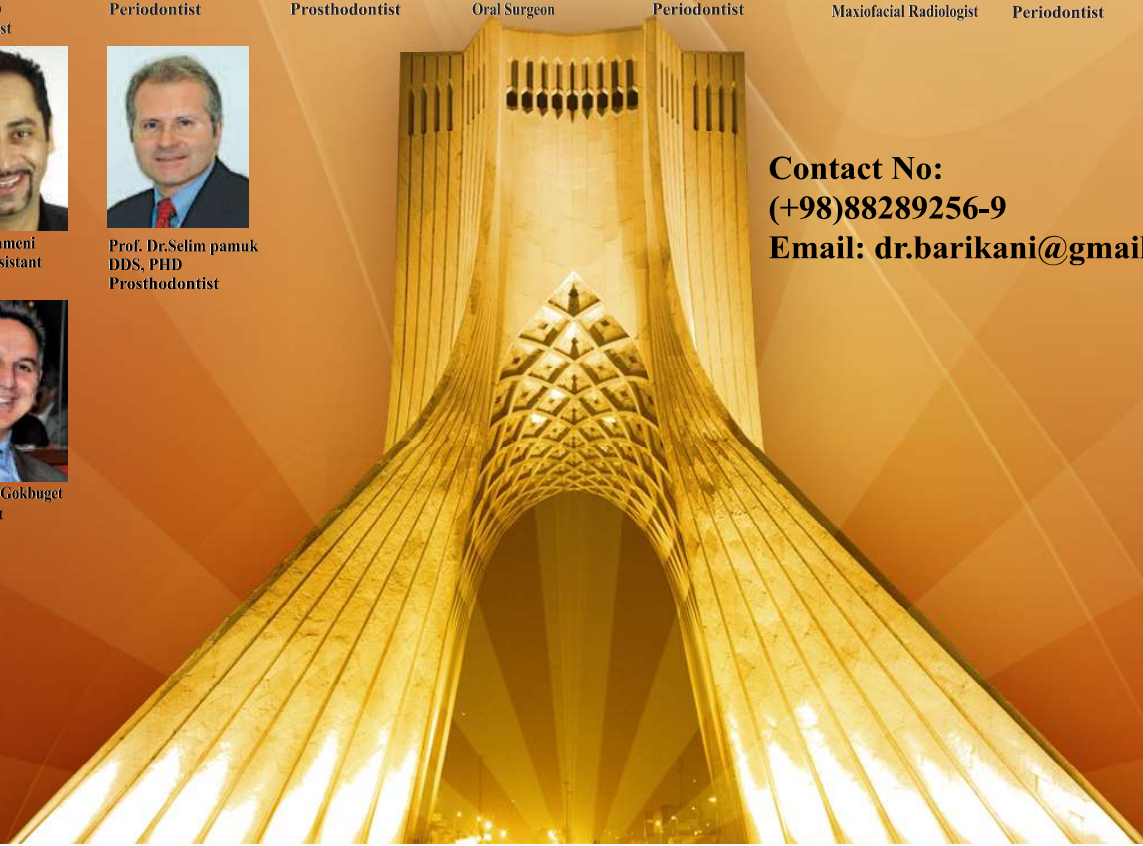

ICOI Affiliate, **Accademia Italiana de Stomatologia Implantoprotetica (AISI)**, Meets in Bologna

On March 2 and 3, 2012, in Bologna, Italy, the Accademia Italiana di Stomatologia Implantoprotetica, AISI, held its 12th International Congress on Clinic Implantology: comparing different techniques.

Under the leadership of Dr. Pier Luigi Floris, AISI President, and Dr. Giuseppe Corinaldesi, from Bologna University Dental Clinic, several professionals as well as academic representatives shared their knowledge and experiences in Implant Dentistry, Prosthodontics, Periodontics, Orthodontics and Maxillo-facial Surgery, trying to present a wide range of different techniques and approaches.

In addition to Italian speakers, AISI hosted some well known professionals from different countries: Dr. Jabbar Hasanov and Dr. Teymur Mammadov, from Azerbaijan, Dr. Baris Tunali, from Turkey, Dr. Mohamed Pedram, from Iran, Prof. Anatolyi Kulakov, from Russia, and Dr. Jack T. Report on the 1st ICOI South Asian Implant Symposium

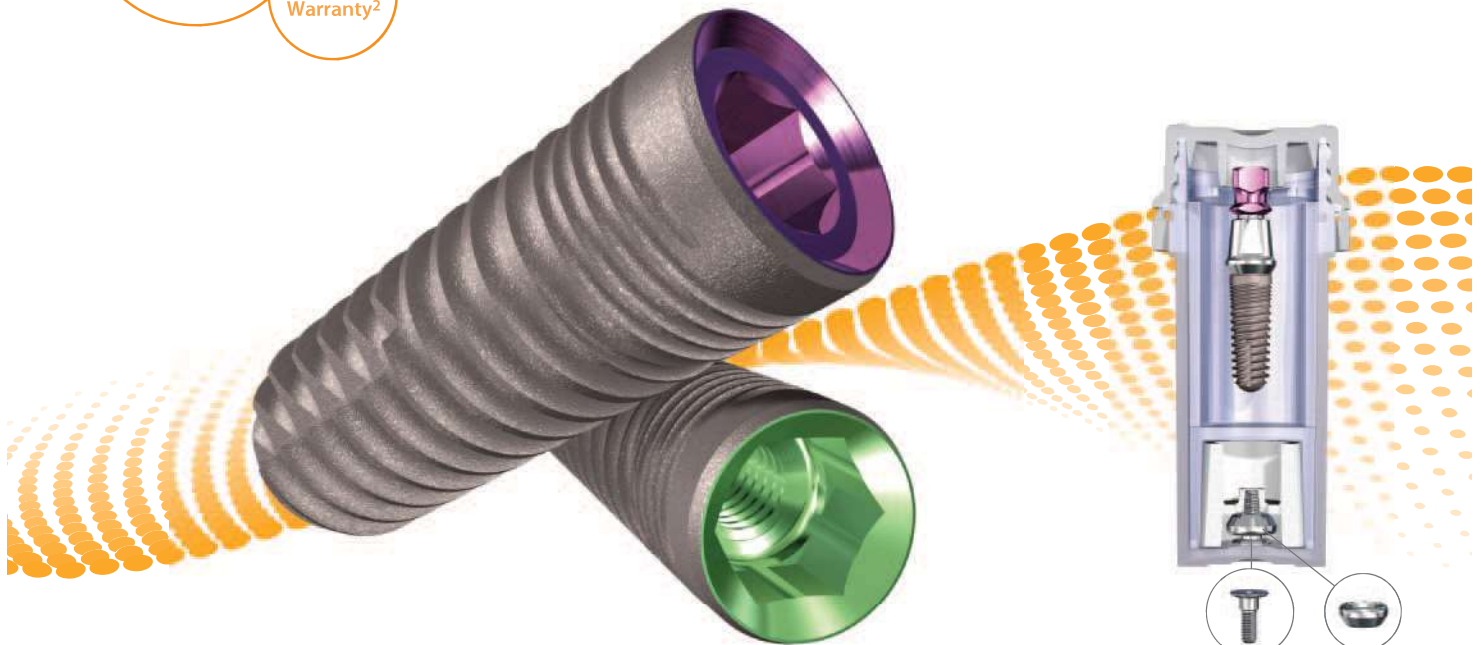
